

ACETAMINOPHEN OR IBUPROFEN Standing Order Form

The Berlin School Health Room Policy allows school nurses to dispense Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen to children over the age of 12 under "Standing Orders" written by our Medical Advisor and with the written permission of the parent or guardian. *Please note that Grade 6 students may not receive these medications under this policy until they turn 12.* These Standing Orders allow Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen to be given only for the three following reasons:

1. Headache, without injury or fever **(Not during Covid-19 Pandemic)**
2. Menstrual cramps
3. Recent dental work

*Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen cannot be given for any other reason, or dose, unless it is requested in writing by your physician.

*Only one dose will be given during a school day. If the student continues to have a problem, the parent will be notified that a medical evaluation is needed.

*If you wish your child to be given medication as indicated in the Standing Order, please complete and sign the below information.

Preferred medication, circle one or both: If nothing is circled, nurses will use their judgment.

Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 650 mg, orally

Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) 400mg, orally
